Note: if a different keypad configuration is requested, please mark “No Button” beside the button number(s) which would not be in your configuration. If you want a button to remain, but with no programming for now, please mark “Blank” for the button name and “NP” for the function description. Please refer to our website or the Lutron website for a description of the various configurations available.

Examples:

- “All On” – turn on all controlled lights
- “All Off” – turn off all controlled lights
- “Vacation” – activate/de-activate system vacation mode and randomly turn specific lights on and off
- “Goodbye” – turn off all interior lights and turn on exterior lights
- “Exterior” – turn on exterior lights to a set level
- “Porch” – turn on the porch light to a set level
- “Movie” – set multiple lights to a set level for movie/TV watching
- “Dinner” – turn off non-required kitchen (or other) lights and set lighting levels to specific level at eating area
- “Green” - activate system timer to reduce (dim) any active light by 5% during peak hydro times
